RE:

Public hearings and meetings on primary or Election Day

We have received many inquiries as to whether public hearings or meetings are permitted on Election Day. The following are the only public meetings that must not be held on Election Day.

- 1. All public hearing held under Zoning Act by city councils, planning boards, and boards of appeals. G. L. c. 40A § 11 (2004 ed.) ¹
- Public hearings by the State Department of Community Affairs on low-rent public housing projects. G. L. c. 1218 § 31 (2004 ed.)

All other public hearings and meetings appear to be permitted on Election Day, although we do not recommend holding them on the day of the election.
